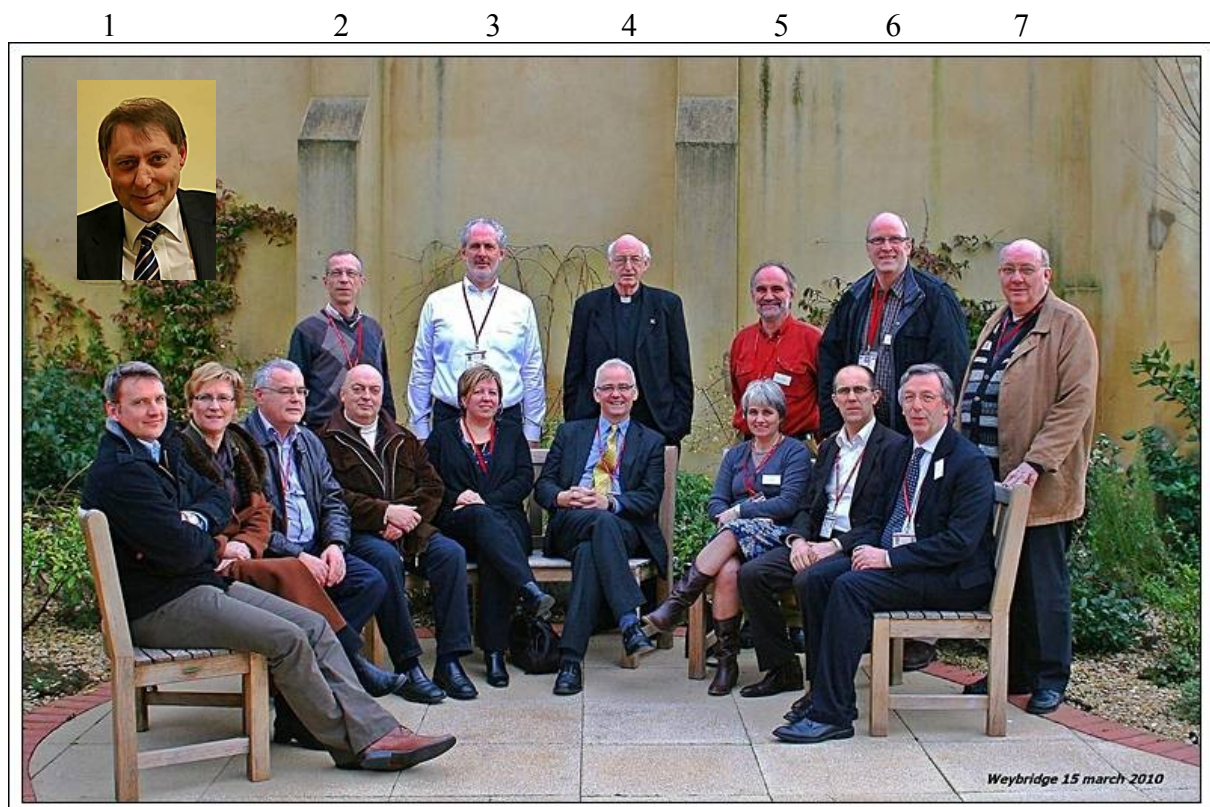


Head Teachers visit to St George's College. March 14 - 16th. Weybridge.
