

Fr. Adrian raises money for Africa by selling used postage stamps.

Confreres with very long memories will remember a young Mr. Adrian way back in the 1960's collecting used stamps to raise money for a Land Rover for our confreres in the Kasai. These stamps were known as "Rover Stamps" since they were sold by Adrian for the purchase of a Land Rover.

Adrian continues this work today collecting used stamps and selling them to raise money. This involves a lot of work since every stamp has to be carefully trimmed before being added to the pile of stamps to be offered to a dealer.

This year Fr. Adrian has raised £60 for confreres in Africa. £60 is the price paid for 8 Kg in weight of British and Foreign Postage stamps. 8 Kg of stamps represents around 20.000 stamps.

Please keep up the good work by sending your stamps to Fr Adrian, c/o of St George's College. You could also help a great deal by trimming the used stamps leaving 1 inch of paper on each of the 2 sides.

Well done Fr Adrian and thank you for all your hard work.
